## Parent and Family Engagement

## Parents as Partners

Anclote Elementary will take the following measures to promote and support parents and family members as an important foundation of the school. In order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals. We will...

- ✓ Family Nights will be held in February each year to provide families with information about state standards and how students are measured on state tests. Examples of standards are provided and questions are answered.
- ✓ Each Fall, teachers will hold conferences to provide parents with information about how they can be informed and monitor their child's progress. MAPS reports and other intervention reports will be sent home after each assessment window to inform parents of their child's progress.
- ✓ Anclote Elementary is dedicated to providing world class instruction to our students. In order to accomplish this, we also provide professional development at least monthly to our instructional staff. In this way, they can meet the needs of all children.
- ✓ Anclote Elementary utilizes a variety of communication methods to ensure all parents receive information on a timely basis. Social media, Messenger and Class Dojo are the main modes of communication.
